PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE IN CHESTER

Interactive public meeting scheduled to discuss Highland Avenue Station improvements

Chester, PA – On Wednesday, March 26, a public open house will be held to discuss development surrounding the Highland Avenue SEPTA train station and its neighboring area. The open house will take place at Chester Community Hospital, 2600 W. 9th Street, Chester, PA, in the Southeast Conference Room from 7:00 to 8:30 pm.

In conjunction with CHPlanning, the Chester City Planning Department is conducting a Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) study in order to plan ways to generate more residential, employment, and retail opportunities in the area surrounding Highland Avenue train station. In order to gain input from the community, the City is asking that all interested Chester residents attend the meeting.

The Chester TOD open house will be interactive in nature as information will be posted at a series of stations, summarizing the existing conditions and the market context reports. There will be no formal presentation, but residents will be given the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback.
