

Project Description

The purpose of the “I-95: City of Chester Overhead Bridges” project is the rehabilitation of eight (8) multi span steel girder bridges (6 Highway bridges and 2 pedestrian bridges) over Interstate I-95 and CSX Railroad in the City of Chester, Pennsylvania. The scope of work includes:

Potter Street

- Re-decking
- Steel & concrete repair for the substructure and superstructure
- New bridge deck joints
- New bridge concrete sidewalk and parapet
- New bridge protective fence
- Drainage improvement
- Painting of the bridge steel superstructure
- Cleaning and resetting of the bridge bearings
- New bridge lighting

Madison St, Upland St, Melrose Ave, Chestnut St Bridge & Ramp E

- Concrete (LMC) Overlay
- Replace bridge deck joints
- Concrete repair for the deck, sidewalk, bridge parapets, and approach sidewalk
- Concrete repair for the substructure
- Steel superstructure repair
- Painting of the bridge steel superstructure
- Cleaning and resetting of the bridge bearings
- Replace bridge protective fence
- East Sidewalk to be closed for Pedestrian on Chestnut Street Bridge

Edgmont Ave

- Concrete repair for the deck, sidewalk, bridge parapets, and approach sidewalk
- Concrete repair for the substructure
- Steel superstructure repair
- Painting of the bridge steel superstructure
- Cleaning and resetting of the bridge bearings
- Replace bridge protective fence
- Drainage improvement
- Deck joint replacement at Abutment A

Walnut St & Crosby St Pedestrian Bridges

- Concrete repair for the deck, bridge parapets, and approach sidewalk
- Concrete repair for the substructure
- Steel superstructure repair
- Painting of the bridge steel superstructure
- Cleaning and resetting of the bridge bearings
- Replace bridge protective fence
- Drainage improvement
- Repair existing bridge lighting
