PHARMACY TECH PROGRAM FOR OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH HAS ADDITIONAL SLOTS

Media – Community Action Agency of Delaware County, Inc.'s (CAADC) Pharmacy Technician Training Program has five additional slots available starting in January. The program is designed to help out-of-school youth gain the skills for a rewarding career including obtaining required credentials and industry recognized certifications. CAADC has partnered with Delaware County Community College for its Pharmacy Technician Training Program which provides instruction to become a pharmacy technician leading to employment in hospitals and community pharmacies. This program includes Pharmacy Technician Certification and an externship.

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be between the ages of 17 and 24
- Currently reside in Delaware County
- Not enrolled in High School
