- Follow a dress code. Students on all centers wear uniforms.
- Get employment assistance before you graduate.
- Receive basic health care.

- A place for kids who only want a GED.
- A boot camp.
- A great way to find a boyfriend or girlfriend.
- A treatment facility for serious medical or mental health issues.
