Purpose, Award Categories and Criteria

The Purpose of this awards dinner is to recognize those students in Chester, who in addition to academic excellence, have demonstrated diverse talents through their contributions and service to their community and school.

To qualify for an award, students in grades 8th thru 12th must be Chester Residents or Attend a School in Chester Upland School District.

**Students in grades 8th-11th may only apply for the "Rising Star Award"
Senior may only apply for "Shining Star Award"**

Please carefully read through all criteria.

Rising Star Award

- Grade Point Average: 3.2 (or higher) for two consecutive quarters. (**Please provide a copy(s) of the student report card outlining his/her GPA per marking period. Transcripts will NOT be accepted. We must be able to clearly determine what the applicants GPA was per each marking period they are eligible for in the current school year. Cumulative GPA's do not determine a student's eligibility for the award.**)
- Letter of Recommendation: Typed recommendation letter from a teacher, guidance counselor, community leader, mentor or spiritual leader. (Letter should be addressed to: City of Chester Scholarship Committee)
- Proven outstanding service in the community, school or likewise. (Submit the attached community service log sheet, as documentation for your service.)

Shining Star Award

- Grade Point Average: 3.2 (or higher) for three consecutive quarters. (Please provide a copy(s) of the student report card outlining his/her GPA per marking period. Transcripts will NOT be accepted. We must be able to clearly determine what the applicants GPA was per each marking period they are eligible for in the current school year. Cumulative GPA's do not determine a student's eligibility for the award.)
- Letter of Recommendation: Typed recommendation letter from a teacher, guidance counselor, community leader, mentor or spiritual leader. (Letter should be addressed to: City of Chester Scholarship Committee)
- Proven outstanding service in the community, school or likewise. (Submit the attached community service log sheet, as documentation for your service.)

- Proven acceptance into a 4 year college/university, to begin in the fall semester of 2016.
(Submit documentation of acceptance)
- Typed double spaced essay (600 word or more) highlighting your career aspirations, and how you plan to impact your hometown, with the skills you acquire through college.

Essays must be in MLA format. Please search Purdue Owl for assistance with MLA format requirements.
