POSTPONED: All Non-Life-Sustaining Businesses To Close

Governor Wolf has announced that the enforcement of the closure of businesses that are not classified as life-sustaining will be delayed until Monday, March 23rd at 8 AM. Additionally, **laundromats have been added** to the list as **life-sustaining businesses**. Please see the attached documents for a list of updated business classifications and frequently asked questions to determine if your business is a life-sustaining business.
