### THE CDC RECOMMENDS CLOTH MASKS


**YOU DO NOT HAVE TO WEAR A MASK:**


**IF YOU ARE SEVERELY ILL, PLEASE GO TO THE HOSPITAL**

### STAY-AT-HOME ORDER

**LATEST ORDER:**

- Chester is still following the "Stay-at-Home" order. If you have to go out it should only be for essential traveling.
- Delaware County is one of several counties in the state that have been hardest hit by COVID-19 .
- The county is **EXPECTED** to move to the yellow phase of reopening on June 5, 2020.
