Mayor Kirkland, Councilwoman West, Councilwoman Williams, Councilman Jacobs and Councilman Morgan,

I am writing to you on behalf of the citizens of Concord Township, many of whom are also ratepayers and customers of the Chester Water Authority. I implore you not to authorize the bid process for the sale of CWA's assets. I have heard from countless residents of Concord Township who are opposed to the sale of this public utility to a private firm and who fear the impending rate increases and lack of public oversight.

Water is central to our life and vital at the most basic level. Such a resource should not be controlled by a private company driven by profit motives. I am not against free enterprise, but I think you will agree that certain things should and must be held by the public for the public's interest. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is one of only 2 states that has adopted an Environmental Rights Amendment. It states that "the people have a right to clean air, pure water and the preservation of the natural, scenic, historic and esthetic values of the environment." When we were sworn into office we vowed to uphold the constitution of the commonwealth. As a councilman myself, I fully appreciate the difficult decisions you are faced with and the financial burdens you must balance. It is not an easy job, and it is often a thankless one. I understand that the sale of the Chester Water Authority assets will provide much needed financial resources to the City of Chester. But when the financial resources realized through the liquidation of the public water authority cease to exist, we will all be poorer for not having this vital resource as an asset for the community of the City of Chester and the broader communities it serves in Delaware County. Privatization of this public trust is not the answer. Please do not authorize the process to sell the assets of CWA. The generations who follow us will thank you for preserving this God-given resource for the public interest. I would like to personally thank you for your service to the City of Chester and for your stewardship of this critical resource.
