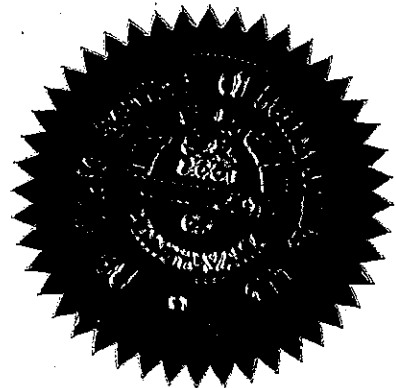

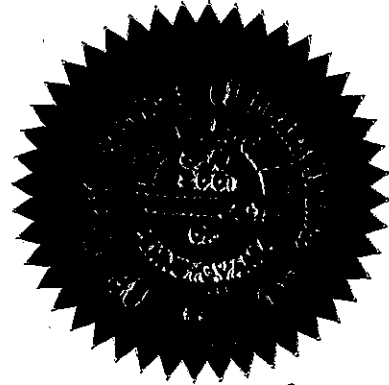

Hello,

My name is Hailey Gerena. I am very concerned with our city's ongoing trash issues. The blocks around my house, specifically (but not limited to) the area of 21st Street, has not had trash collection in THREE WEEKS. This is absolutely unacceptable. I understand there are circumstances, like a shortage of staff due to COVID-19 or inclement weather, but what is the solution? What are we to do? This is detrimental to our city's morale and reputation. Chester is already looked down upon by other parts of Delaware County for various reasons, but for our city to allow our streets to look like landfills is intolerable. How can we convince outsiders to stop coming here to dump their old mattresses, furniture, and other waste, if our city does not care enough to make sure our own garbage is handled responsibly? Additionally, Chester has some of the highest Coronavirus rates in the county. Leaving trash on our streets for weeks is a major health issue, likely contributing to our infection rates. I am not looking for excuses, reasons, rationales, or defenses- I am asking for solutions. I am asking what can we do as citizens, what can you do as our elected officials, to ensure we are not left buried in weeks worth of trash during the worst global pandemic of our lifetimes?
