## Council Meeting Update

(Wednesday, February 23, 2022)

According to the most recent reports, Since the start of the pandemic, Chester has had up to 6745 positive COVID cases. The number of weekly reported cases has decreased from 68 to 27 cases. We currently have 60% of Chester residents partially vaccinated and 51% are fully vaccinated. The school-age population (ages 10-19) is up to 33% partially vaccinated and 27% fully vaccinated.

Vaccines and booster shots are free and available to everyone.

COVID PCR testing is available at Everest Urgent Care and Keystone First.

We want to continue to encourage everyone 5 and older to get vaccinated and everyone who is eligible to get their booster shot.

We currently have vaccines and booster shots available at ChesPenn, Keystone First Wellness Center, Everest Urgent Care, and your local pharmacy.

Finally, March is prostate cancer month and we want to encourage all men to visit their primary care provider to get screened.

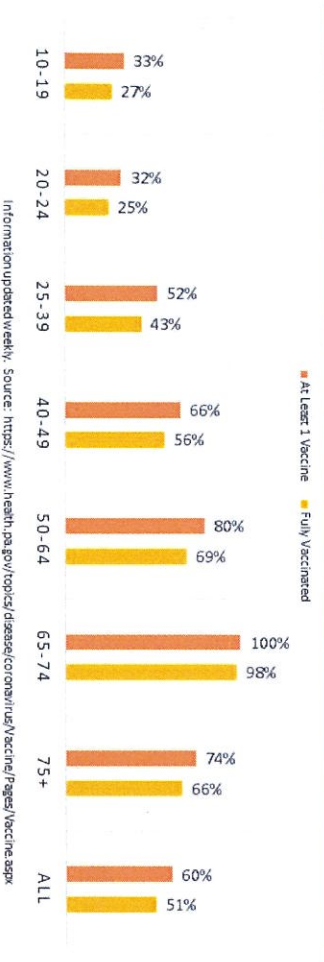
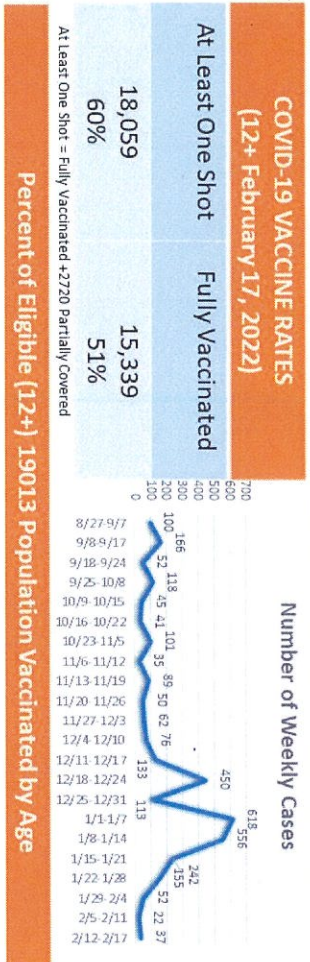

Some Highlights since our last full report on January 28,

- 155 additional people have received at least one shot of the vaccine.
- 338 have become fully vaccinated.
- 51% of residents in 19013 are fully vaccinated
- 60% of residents in 19013 have received at least one shot of the vaccine.
- 107 additional youth have received at least one shot of the vaccine
- 145 youth aged 12-19 became fully vaccinated.
- 27% of youth aged 12-19 are fully vaccinated.
- 33% of youth aged 12-19 have received at least one vaccine.
