## Council Meeting Update

April 27, 2022

Good morning. The PA Department of Health reports that there have been 6837 positive cases reported in Chester since the start of the pandemic. Since the last council meeting on April 13, there have been 23 reported positive cases. Cases are slowly starting to increase again. Research experts believe the number of positive cases is undercounted given the common use of at-home tests. The CDC reports that the Delaware county community COVID level remains Low. Unfortunately, the data regarding vaccines and booster shots has not been updated since March 4th. The state has not provided guidance as to when we can expect the updated information.

On Friday, April 29, 2022, state representative Brian Kirkland will be having a Cancer Awareness luncheon. It will be held from 10-2 in the upper Chichester township building (8500 Furey Rd, Aston, PA). RSVPs are required to attend.
