Council Meeting COVID Update

September 14, 2022

The Pennsylvania Department of Health reports that there have been 7661 positive cases reported in Chester since the start of the pandemic. There have been 48 positive COVID-19 cases reported in Chester in September so far. The CDC has also reported 649 cases of Monkeypox in the state of Pennsylvania. Delaware County is currently experiencing a medium level of COVID-19 transmission. According to the CDC, people may choose to mask at any time. Those at high risk for severe illness, those with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should wear a mask. The Delaware County Health Department encourages the public to follow the CDC's recommendations for universal masking indoors regardless of vaccination status

COVID-19 vaccinations & boosters are available on September 26 from 11:00– 5:00 at the Delaware County Health Center located at 151 W. 5th St. Walk-ins are offered, but you are encouraged to schedule an appointment by calling (484) 276 – 2100. The Delaware County Health Department is also sponsoring a community blood drive and COVID-19 vaccine and booster clinic on September 28. The vaccine clinic will be from 11:00 am—1:00 pm, and the blood drive will be from 1:00-6:00 pm. The clinic will be held at the Chester Senior Center at 721 Hayes Street, Chester PA. To sign up or for more information please call 610-497-3550.

The Chester City Hall Health Department will be giving away COVID-19 test kits on September 19th, 22nd, and 27th from 6:00-7:00 and on September 28, from 11:00 am-1:00 pm in the lobby. We will have a billboard going up for cancer awareness that is sponsored by Roe Fabricators. On October 13th, we will have a Health Partners Luncheon from 11:00-2:00 in the Chester City Hall Community Room. Finally, on October 20th we will have a Breast Cancer Awareness Luncheon from 10:00-3:30 at the Keystone First Wellness Center.

The City of Chester is interested in establishing an Eligibility List for the position of Patrol Officer. Applications will be available at the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 1 Fourth Street, Chester, PA 19013, beginning **September 12, 2022 through September 30, 2022** between the hours of 10:00am-4pm, **Monday – Friday**. A non-refundable processing fee of **Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) Money Order or Cashier's Check payable to the City of Chester** is required **at the time of obtaining the application**. If there are any questions, please contact (610) 447-7795 for further information.

Completed applications include Proof of:

1. Age 21 years at the date of testing on **October 15, 2022**
2. US Citizenship (Birth/Baptismal Certificate is acceptable)
3. High School Diploma/GED
4. Valid Driver's License/Passport
5. Proof of Veteran's Status, if applicable
6. Proof of 120 Certification, if applicable

Applications must be returned in person by the applicant, along with the items listed above for verification (copies are acceptable), to the Office of the City Clerk during the hours listed above **before or on September 30, 2022**. There will be no exceptions. If hired, applicants residing outside of the City of Chester must establish residency within three (3) months of date of hire.

*Applicants will have to **PASS a PHYSICAL AGILITY ON (October 9, 2022 @ 8am at Widener University)** prior to being permitted to take the written Civil Service Test. **ALSO, PASS a READING COMPREHENSION TEST (TBA)** as outlined by the Municipal Police Officer Education and Training Commission as part of the hiring process for the City of Chester.

The WRITTEN TEST will be given on October 15, 2022 at City Hall, Community Room (off of Rt. 291). CHECK IN TIME WILL BE AT 9:30am. TEST WILL BEGIN AT 10:00 SHARP!! PLEASE BRING ID!
