## **Council Meeting COVID Update**

**December 28, 2022,**

The Pennsylvania Department of Health reported 85 positive COVID-19 cases in Chester in December. Research experts believe the number of positive cases is undercounted, given the common use of at-home tests. Delaware County is currently experiencing a medium level of COVID-19 transmission. According to the CDC, people may choose to mask at any time. You should wear a mask if you have symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19. Also, if you are at high risk for severe illness, consider wearing a mask indoors and taking additional precautions. The CDC has also reported 3 cases of Monkeypox in Pennsylvania since the last council meeting on December 21.

COVID-19 vaccinations & boosters will be available on January 9 from 11:00– 5:00 at the Delaware County Health Center located at 151 W. 5th St. Walk-ins are offered, but you are encouraged to schedule an appointment by calling (484) 276 – 2100. You can also always go to [vaccines.gov](https://www.vaccines.gov) for the most up-to-date appointment availability for vaccines and boosters.
