



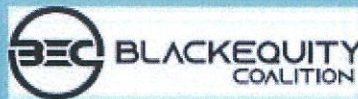

## **Council Meeting COVID Update**

**March 8, 2023 (7:00 pm)**

The Pennsylvania Department of Health reported 60 positive COVID-19 cases in Chester since the last council meeting on February 22. Research experts believe the number of positive cases is undercounted, due to at-home testing and residents who may have mild symptoms that do not get tested. The CDC states that people in Delaware County may choose to mask anytime due to a medium level of COVID-19 transmission. The City will host their first annual Women's Health Conference this Saturday, March 11 from 9:00 am – 1:00 pm at Widener University's Latham Hall. The Keystone Speaker will be renowned radio personality and stroke survivor Patty Jackson. We encourage everyone to consider getting the vaccine and booster shot if you haven't already. The Health Department is partnering with Woodlyn Pharmacy and the Black Equity Coalition to sponsor a vaccine, booster, flu and Shingles shot clinic on March 22 from 11:00-1:00 at the City Hall in the computer room. Finally, Chester City Hall offers free blood pressure screenings every Wednesday from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm in the lobby.
