

PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Chester, Department of Parks, Public Property and Recreation will provide free lunches in conjunction with arts & crafts, recreational and educational activities at various City Parks and playgrounds from **July 5, 2023 to August 16, 2023**.

Lunches are available free of charge to all children at sites operated under the control of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Public Property. Lunches will be available at the following sites:

Urgent Care-Highland Ave; St. Daniels Church/Hope- 9th & Kerlin Street; Bethany Church; World of Hope; Chester Park; Sun Village Park; Memorial Park; Washington Park; Holy City Park; and Cornerstone Church. All children are served the same lunch at no charge and **there is no discrimination in the course of food service.**

The Department of Parks, Public Property and Recreation's policy is that all eligible children have access to the benefits of the Summer Food Program, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or handicap.
