- **PROVIDE SAFE AND ENGAGING LEARNING EXPERIENCES THAT HELP CHILDREN REALIZE THEIR FULL POTENTIAL.**
- **SUPPORT WORKING FAMILIES BY ENSURING THEIR CHILDREN ARE SAFE AND PRODUCTIVE WHEN THEY ARE OUT OF THEIR CLASSROOMS.**
- **BUILD STRONGER COMMUNITIES BY INVOLVING STUDENTS, PARENTS, BUSINESS LEADERS, AND ADULT VOLUNTEERS IN THE LIVES OF YOUNG PEOPLE, THEREBY PROMOTING POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS AMONG YOUTH, FAMILIES, AND ADULTS.**
- **ENGAGE FAMILIES, SCHOOLS, AND COMMUNITY PARTNERS IN ADVANCING THE WELFARE OF OUR CHILDREN.**

**WHEREAS, LIGHTS ON AFTERSCHOOL PROVIDES CRITICAL SUPPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC GROWTH AND WELL-BEING OF YOUTH AND OFFERS NEW EXPERIENCES AND OPPORTUNITIES THAT HELP YOUNG PEOPLE LEARN AND GROW. AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS PROVIDE INNOVATIVE, HANDS-ON OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH TO ENGAGE IN LEARNING AND CONNECT WITH CARING ADULTS AND PEERS IN A SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT. THESE SUPPORTS ARE ALL THE MORE IMPORTANT TODAY, IN THE WAKE OF THE PANDEMIC.**

**WHEREAS, *LIGHTS ON AFTERSCHOOL*, THE NATIONAL CELEBRATION OF AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS HELD THIS YEAR ON OCTOBER 26TH PROMOTES THE IMPORTANCE OF QUALITY AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS IN THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, FAMILIES, AND COMMUNITIES.**
